The facility has all new staff and is ready for visitors to come and see the

renovations and new exhibits. In the summer it is open every day until 5 pm.

It is hoped that additional funds can be raised to expand the facility and make it even better. In the past the museum would have about 150,000 visitors a year and people have visited from 41 states and 27 foreign countries.
