Program

PE Robbie Burke introduced Bill Huber as our speaker today. He is a local attorney and lifelong resident of St. Marys. He is the author of two books about his family history and is a lecturer on Genealogy at OSU-Lima. Bill became interested in the War of 1812 while researching his family tree.



The War of 1812 had a deep impact on our nation's history. It was our 2^{nd} war for independence and is often the "forgotten war." When the war began the United States didn't have any military leaders, no money, and only 8 warships compared to 600 British warships.

During the War of 1812 Harrison made St Marys his headquarters for a period of time. It was called Fort Barbie and approximately 3000 troops were stationed here. The Ohio Historical Society website contains historical letters documenting Fort Barbie.

Bill discussed many interesting misconceptions of the War of 1812 and provided a fascinating perspective not found in history textbooks.
