He was glad to be home for his final visit.

DG Gary presented a certificate to PP Randy Elsass for our club's support to the "End Polio Now" campaign last year.



DG Gary's address talked about his road to becoming District Governor. He talked about how he was invited to join Rotary three times before he said yes. He asked us all to ask people to join, several times in necessary. He has a goal of 2% membership increase in the district this year.
